She collaborated with American poet Lisa C. Taylor on *The Other Side of Longing* which was chosen as the Gerson Reading at the University of Connecticut, 2011. In June 2019, *Vietnam Veterans Unbroken: Conversations on Trauma and Resiliency* was published by McFarland & Co. In 2020 as a member of the New Mexico Arts Imaginative Collective, Loring served as the Poetry Curator for "Sense of Wonder Experience" that premiered both the Art and Music Reveals in December 2020.
